



NURSE AIDE CNA

The Nurse Aide training program is a 2 to 3 month program that prepares a student to become a vital member of the health care team in the role of a nurse aide/nursing assistant/CNA caring for residents in skilled nursing facilities, hospitals, rehab centers and other healthcare facilities. Program topics include hygienic care, denture care, feeding residents, proper care and handling of residents, privacy, infection control and resident rights.

A student successfully completing this program will receive a certificate of completion from HACC, Central Pennsylvania's Community College, and will be eligible to take the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program examination administered by Credentia. Upon passing both the NNAAP written and skills performance exam, the student is placed on the PA Nurse Aide Registry. (A student who successfully completes the nurse aide training program can be employed for 120 days before they must take the NNAAP examination.)"
